Capstone Project	Deliverables
<b>Resurrection of old Hospice Club on campus</b>	Club President Handbook; Developing partnerships with community agencies; Training of next President; Set up of Community Page on My.USU
<b>Heading a fundraising committee for local agency</b>	Assessment of skills/tools currently used; Trainings for new on-line tools, Guidebook with detailed instructions; Hosting Training Workshops, translation of materials to better target partner agency
<b>Developing school afterschool program to help students identify hobbies</b>	Hosting afterschool workshops; developing training materials, recruiting volunteers across campus for guest speaking; create handbook to be used to expand program to additional schools/over future years
<b>Creating a bike commuting program for Aggies Elevated Students</b>	Resources to be taught in future classes, including videos, reading materials, and quizzes to test knowledge; securing 2 Aggie Blue Bikes to be used for program through Blue Goes Green Grant; training of current student to run program 2016
<b>Youth City Council Leadership Summit</b>	One day summit focused on hunger in the community; Develop activities and educational materials; complete fundraising 5K event to donate to community agency; Create resources for future years
<b>Promotion of Zimride</b>	Completed and was awarded Blue Goes Green Grant for Zimride, Carpooling tool for Logan Campus; developed and executed marketing plan to raise awareness and use across campus
<b>Summer Camp at Willard Zoo</b>	Develop summer camp for youth at Willard Zoo; developed schedule/recruitment materials; designed all education and activities during camp; Handbook to be distributed for best practices and future camps; Camp to be ran by scholar after graduation
<b>Develop Resources for Sustainability and Expansion of Alternative Breaks</b>	Develop Handbook resources for Alt Break participants – including student director, student leaders, and staff advisor; Create and present training materials for all attendees including pre trip training and reflection materials; recruit for full attendance of trip; Help to train and prepare new student Director
<b>Creating mural at local elementary school</b>	Developed education around environmental theme for elementary students; partnering with class to determine mural design; will be including students in the actual creation/painting of mural on school shed
<b>Buddy Bench at Elementary School</b>	Creation of anti-bullying curriculum and activities for classrooms. Plan for purchasing a 'buddy bench' for playground to encourage student inclusion.
<b>Event Planning Guide for Local Nonprofit</b>	Organized annual event for agency, then used experience to develop in depth handbook and website for future event planning.
